Isaiah

- 1) Prophesied during the 8th century, ca. 74-680 BC
 - 2) Main theme: Israel's Messiah Isaiah 2; 6-7; 7:14; 9:1-2; 11:1ff; 42:6; 49:6, 52:13 through 53, & 65
 - 3) The Northern Kingdom destroyed by Assyria ca. 722-21 BC

The greatest theme

Isaiah 49:6-Israel-the light to The Gentiles

Future: Israel's Magnificant restoration: Chpt 30

The Magnificent Restoration of Israel \$\square\$ 1) Vs. 1-2: God's Warning

Israel has not <u>trusted</u> God as a total corporate nation since rejecting Jesus

The word trust as here Occurs 154x in the OT

In the Hebrew means:
a) To take refuge; Ps. 2:12
b) To lean on; Ps. 56:3
c) To roll on; Ps. 22:8
They do not trust God

Israel has never fully proclaimed her trust in God corporately ever They are:

A called out nation: Gen. 12:1-3
Who bore Messiah: Gen. 49:8-10
Who wrote The Bible: Romans 3:1-2
Within Israel, then & now, there has always been a remnant

Regardless, God still has a future for the same nation that lives in rebellion



2) Vs. 1-2: God's Restoration

God will restore Israel

Vs. 15-17: Israel will still look for help elsewhere
Egypt was a real nation that they were consorting with
Making treaties to guard against outside invasions

God declares through Isaiah that He will bring judgment
It will be sudden
It will be ultimate

Then in true Hebraic form Isaiah jumps forward centuries

Vs. 18-20: The God of grace, mercy
The God Who hears
Will restore His people to Jerusalem

Those who teach Israel will no longer be discarded

Vs. 21: They will hear a voice say: "This is the way, walk in it."
